Investigation & Interview Techniques



- 2-day course (max. 12 participants).
- This course focuses on the following topics: what are the objectives of an incident investigation (and what not!); Insight into the incident investigation process; Organizing an investigation; Collecting data / evidence; Interview skills & techniques; Drafting a timeline; Communication and reporting both the progress and the findings of the incident investigation; Drawing conclusions; Drafting recommendations; Reflective learning.
- After this course, participants will be able to engage as an investigator/ facilitator in the process of incident investigation.
- This course is ideal for those investigators who want to receive advanced investigation skills and knowledge about the investigation process.

This course can also be delivered online.



Tripod Beta Introduction



- ½-day course (max. 25 participants).
- This workshop is an additional non-Investigator module to support effective Tripod Beta adoption. To fully integrate Tripod Beta as an incident analysis method into the organisation, it is essential that stakeholders involved at all levels are familiar with the basic knowledge / philosophy behind Tripod. This training program covers the fundamental concepts about the process and the objectives of the Tripod Beta method.
- This module is ideal for, among others, managers, legal advisors and others who are not part of the investigation team, but who do have a role to play in the process of 'learning from incidents'.
- No prior knowledge or experience is required.

This course can also be delivered online.



Tripod Beta Analysis



- 2-day course (max. 12 participants).
- This course focuses on the Tripod Beta analysis method. The training program offers thorough knowledge of the methodology, as well as the philosophy (science) behind Tripod; advanced skills and knowledge of the Tripod Beta method and how to improve the quality of the analysis (and thus the recommendations).
- After this course, the participants will be able to make Tripod Beta analyses based on gathered facts & findings during the investigation phase. Participants will also be able to review analyses from other investigators.
- There will be extra practising using your cases. As a result, participants will improve their skills and gain more trust and understanding in the application of Tripod Beta.
- This course includes the accreditation for Tripod Beta Bronze Practitioner.

This course can also be delivered online.



Tripod Beta Full Practitioner



- 4-day course (max. 12 participants).
- This course focuses on the knowledge, mindset, tools and skills required to perform a full incident research process using the Tripod Beta analysis. This 4-day program is based on the 2-day Tripod Beta analysis course. In addition, this course also focuses on the following topics: objectives of an incident investigation; Insight into the incident investigation process; Organizing an investigation; Collecting data/evidence; Interview skills & techniques; Drafting a timeline; Communication and reporting both progress and findings; Drawing conclusions; Drafting recommendations.
- © Objectives: After this course, participants can participate in all phases of the incident research process, including the Tripod Beta analysis.
- This course includes the accreditation for Tripod Beta Bronze Practitioner.
- For groups <6 persons, we offer this course in a 3-day program instead.



Tripod Beta Software



- 1-day course (max. 12 participants).
- The program focuses entirely on the application of Tripod Beta using the IncidentXP software suite.
- Note: All regular Tripod Beta courses are mainly focused on the methodology and not so much on the use of the software. During these courses, the trainer does show a quick-tour of the software and demonstrates how a Tripod Beta diagram can be composed using the software. However, many other functionalities are not covered. That is why this 1-day software training is an ideal addition to the regular Tripod Beta training courses.

This course can also be delivered online.



Tripod Beta Refresher



- 1-day course (max. 12 participants).
- Accompanied by an experienced lead Investigator / accredited trainer, we offer trained Tripod Beta investigators the opportunity to refresh their knowledge of the method. During the workshop there is ample opportunity to share knowledge and experiences with colleague-investigators. After a brief refresher, we mainly practice using your own cases.
- Participants must have previously participated in either 2, 3 or 4-day Tripod Beta course.

This course can also be delivered online.



Tripod Beta Master Class



- 2-day course (max. 12 participants).
- Our Master Class is for experienced Tripod Beta practitioners and offers the opportunity to get acquainted with the latest developments in the field of Tripod and to share experiences and challenges with other Tripod professionals. The program is specifically focused on deepening and broadening knowledge and skills.
- Note: Admission requirements apply to our Master Class. With this, we try to achieve the highest possible level of learning. Participants are Silver, or Gold accredited Tripod practitioners, or they have the intention to become Silver or Gold.




Post-training Support & Coaching on the job

- The 'Stichting Tripod Foundation' (STF) is the official guardian of the Tripod philosophy. All our Tripod Beta courses are certified by the STF.
- Participants will receive a comprehensive training package. The materials include the official Tripod Beta User Guidance, which is published by the Energy Institute on behalf of the STF.
- Also, participants will receive our handy pocket-size 'Tripod Beta Roadmap' which contains all the necessary information and practical tools for applying Tripod Beta in the field. This guide has been developed by Geniozz and is considered indispensable by many as a perfect tool to guide investigators during their first experiences with Tripod Beta in the field.




Tripod Beta Accreditation



The STF has created accreditations for Tripod Beta users, trainers and assessors. The implementation of the (in this case) user accreditation is provided by Geniozz in the form of a 'knowledge test' on the last day of the Tripod Beta training (note: this knowledge test only applies to the 3 and 4-day programs). If this test is successfully completed, the participant will achieve the status of 'Tripod Beta Bronze Practitioner'.

For additional information about the accreditation process (Silver and Gold) we refer to the website of the Energy Institute (EI). The EI provides the secretariat for all accreditations on behalf of STF.
